At PBL, Jetske leads the multi-year, interdisciplinary program The Role of Government in Societal Sustainability Transformations, which focuses on what governments can do to stimulate and facilitate the transformation towards a climate-neutral society, circular economy, and sustainable mobility and food system. The program collaborates with various universities. Previously, Jetske led the work on societal engagement (2021-2023), the 2020 Environmental Outlook (Balans van de Leefomgeving), the work on Inclusive Green Growth (2014-2017), Nature-Inclusive Agriculture (2017-2019) and Behavioural Public Policy (2016-2020). In 2019 Jetske was acting department head, from 2014-2017 she was vice-chair of the employee council (Ondernemingsraad).
